Many families in Zambia cannot afford to send their children to school. Our partner organisation **Association Pope John 23rd (APJ23)** runs 6 community schools in marginalized compounds. They aim to improve literacy and ICT knowledge to give the children and youth better prospects in a digitalised world.
