The Copywriting and Proofreading Officer will develop Medair's presence in German-speaking Switzerland in order to increase brand awareness and quality engagement with our audiences.

#### **Project Overview**

Medair Global Support Office (GSO) provides operational guidance for country programmes, along with both technical and compassionate support for our relief workers. Within our GSO and affiliate offices, we are also responsible for promoting the work of Medair to the world, to raise and manage the funds needed to run our life-saving and sustaining programmes and to recruit international and GSO staff.

The Engagement team focuses on raising awareness of Medair's work and the humanitarian needs of the people we serve through digital platforms, media, advertisement and events. With the aim to increase the levels of awareness and engagement of people who hear about Medair, providing dynamic and accessible platforms on-line and off-line for them to show their interest and to develop their connection with us.
