The Role: Event Management (80%)

- Getting quotes from & secure venues & caterings;
- Coordinating with our topic leads volunteers;
- Briefing speakers & moderators;
- Managing logistics at the events;
- Managing administrative tasks;
- Preparing & sending follow-up emails.

Furthermore, you will have the opportunity to take ownership of your own project, e.g. plan your own event or workshop (to be confirmed within the first weeks of the internship).
