Responsibilities and Duties

The Country Coordinator plays an essential role in strengthening relationships with partners and assuring quality of the Mission 21 cooperation programme in South Sudan and its various projects. The position entails the following responsibilities:

- To provide leadership and to manage the Country Coordination Office South Sudan
- To manage the partnerships of Mission 21 in South Sudan and in the Sub-Region
- To facilitate capacity development of the partner organisations
- To manage the institutional fund raising of Mission 21 for South Sudan
- To network with relevant actors in South Sudan and in the Sub-Region
- To represent Mission 21 in South Sudan and in the Sub-Region with relevant authorities and civil society organisations

Requirements

- University degree in relevant fields such as development studies, peacebuilding, international relations, economics or social studies
- Excellent knowledge and demonstrated experience in project cycle and result based programme management
