YOUR MAIN TASKS

- Provide overall strategic steering and technical guidance to the project team, partners and stakeholders through results-oriented project cycle management
- Ensure the application of an MSD approach and related tools (including DCED Standard for Results Measurement) through capacity building and coaching
- Ensure the functioning of an effective knowledge management and learning system and actively engage on communication through various media
- Effectively manage the relationship to the donors by ensuring timeliness and quality of reports and by providing on-demand technical documentation and support
- Ensure the functioning of the projects overall governance system and processes, including the maintenance of good relations with partners and stakeholders
- Assure overall quality of project implementation in operational, procedural and administrative matters, and compliance with donor requirements and Helvetas internal processes
- Ensure effective coordination and exchanges between RECONOMY and other projects implemented by Helvetas and the wider organization, seeking synergies and best utilization of resources and ideas.

YOUR QUALIFICATIONS

- An academic degree (Master or equivalent) in economics, development studies or similar social sciences
- At least 10 years of experience in development cooperation, in particular in the area of economic development
- Proven track record in results-oriented Project Cycle Management (management of larger and complex projects) and team leadership, with focus on strategic steering

- Excellent knowledge of the MSD approach applied to different contexts and thematic areas, as well as knowledge of related tools (especially DCED Standard)
- Provision of strategic and technical guidance (through training and capacity building, consultancy, coaching etc.)
- Specialization in at least one of the following topics: private sector development (PSD), vocational skills development (VSD), private sector engagement (PSE), public-private partnerships (PPP) / advocacy, financial sector development (FSD) incl. guarantee facilities/instruments, digital transformation, youth employment / labor market development, Conflict sensitivity / transformation
- Experience in the field of environment and climate change and gender
- Ability to research and analyze, synthesize and efficiently write high quality technical and documents other documents in English language
- Experience working in the private sector

This requires very strong communication and negotiation skills in English (written and spoken), ideally also in Russian and/or a language spoken in the region.
